Remember that percussion instruments are instruments which you can hit, scrape or shake. We'll use your instrument for future tasks.



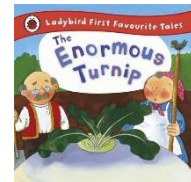
History:

Retell "The Enormous Turnip" and/or write your own version. You can find this story and alternative versions online e.g. "The Enormous Potato"




Reading is key!
