




Rook's Nest Academy Homework

(Children need to learn that Wakefield is in the North of England, in the county of West Yorkshire).</p> <p>Is Wakefield a village, town or city? (Explain that Wakefield is a city because it has a cathedral).</p>

(https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=hheo1VGZVvs)</p> <p>Imagine that you are the snail. Write a letter to your friend telling them about your adventure around the world with the whale. Try to describe your thoughts and feelings as well as what happened.
